FIORDLAND Fishing



Whether you are passionate about game fishing, coastal fishing, deep-sea fishing, or simply enjoy observing others engage in this activity, SEA Fiordland provides a plethora of options to explore.

Our fishing trips feature a diverse array of species, including Southern Bluefin Tuna, Trumpeter, Kahawai, Albacore Tuna, Kingfish, Crayfish (lobster), Bluecod, Tarakihi, Hapuka, Butterfish, Moki, Mussels, Cockles, & Pipi, among others.

Onboard, we offer lobster pots known locally as cray pots, providing a unique opportunity to learn the skill of pot pulling while identifying female crayfish (lobster) from local populations.

During the summer months, smaller Southern Bluefin Tuna are available. In contrast, larger specimens are generally found in open waters during the autumn/winter months.

The excitement of witnessing baitfish bust-ups & observing the vibrant birdlife interacting with the water adds an exhilarating dimension to our expeditions, ensuring that participants remain captivated & eager to discover which species may surface next.

Freediving + Scuba Diving



Diving, Freediving & Spear Fishing in Fiordland is known as a world class opportunity & provides a unique experience exploring underwater caves & marine life.

Adventurers can discover sunken wrecks & vibrant ecosystems beneath the surface, including expansive kelp forests teeming with colorful fish & playful seals.

The breathtaking fiords, shaped by glacial activity 16,000 years ago, present an exceptional diving environment.

Divers can navigate steep Jurassic cliff faces adorned with black coral—deceptively white in appearance—alongside smaller, more vibrant red corals. The abundance of marine life offers ample opportunities for enthusiastic spear-fishers.

This combination of adventure & tranquility, along with everything Fiordland has to offer, allows divers to enjoy the stunning underwater peaks & valleys at their own pace.

FIORDLAND Hunting



Whether on land or at sea, Fiordland presents a wealth of opportunities to encounter its diverse wildlife.

In a single day, one might fish for blue cod, dive for crayfish, & then venture into the hills in pursuit of the elusive Chamois, Red Deer or Wapiti.

Red deer represent the most prevalent species among the deer population in Fiordland. Dusk and dawn are particularly fruitful times to observe them as they emerge from the bush to graze on grassy river flats or clearings, especially during spring.

New Zealand boasts only one wild herd of Wapiti, located in the remote regions of Fiordland, specifically between Sutherland and Charles Sound, bordering the eastern side of Lake Te Anau.

The roar season is always an exhilarating time to be in Fiordland, so be sure to secure your spot promptly.

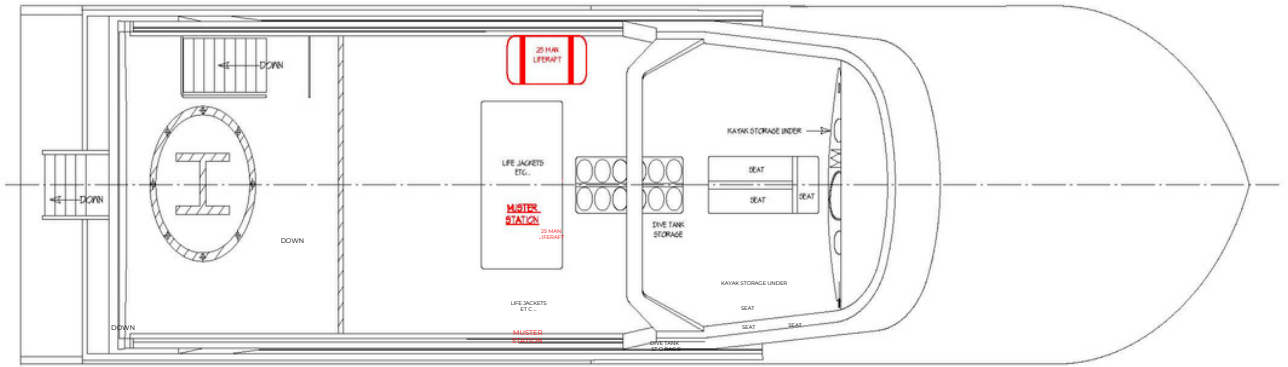

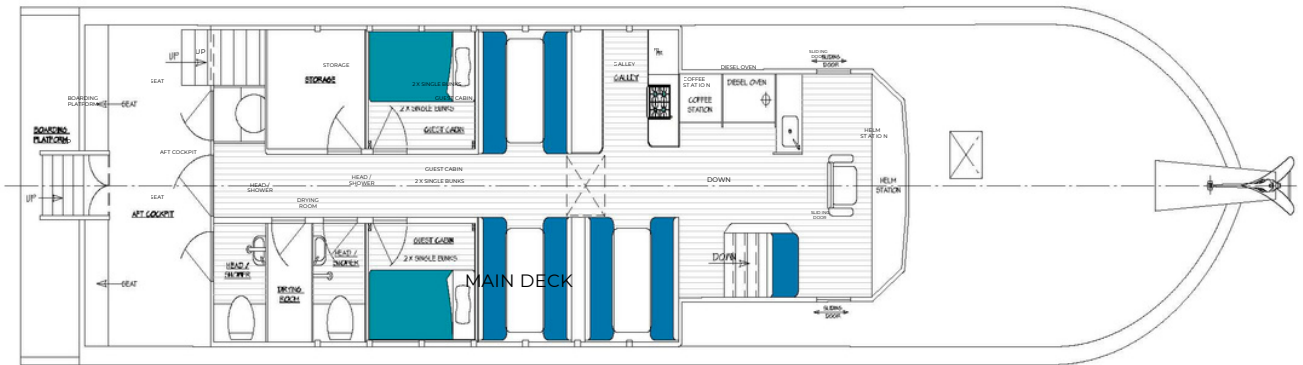


VESSEL Layout

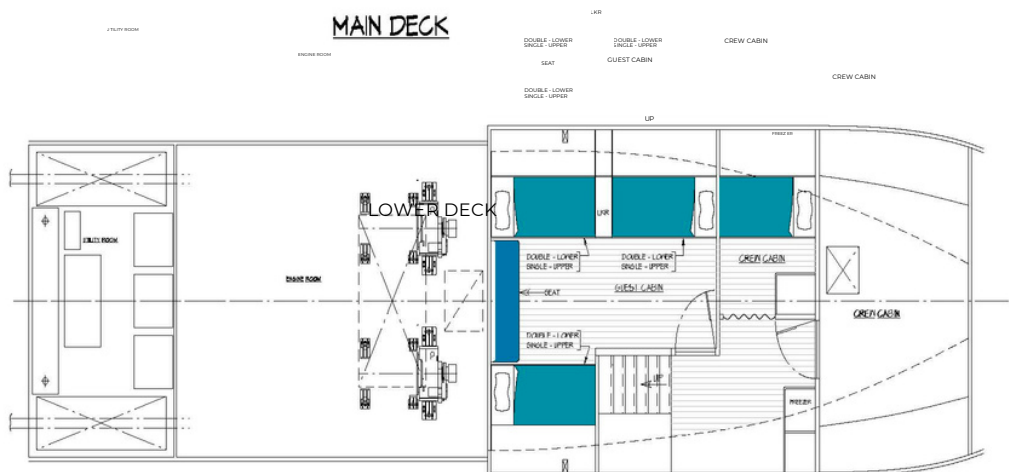


UPPER DECK

If seafood is not your thing, you will not go hungry. We offer a variety of fruit, fresh vegetables, New Zealand Lamb, Venison & other meat options & stores to ensure we have a range of food on offer. All dietary requirements can be managed when notified in advance.

- Fishing gear — rods and tackle for deep drops, coastal fishing and game fishing
- Fishing species: blue cod, bass/hāpuka, kingfish, albacore tuna, trumpeter, terakihi, southern bluefin tuna, bluenose, kahawai, butterflyfish along with paua, cockles, crayfish, mussels and more. Pull lobster pots and see some enormous Fiordland bucks.
- Diving, free diving, spearfishing and snorkelling options
- Fiordland - Wreck dive — the SS Waikare, wrecked in Dusky Sound in 1910
- Fiordland - Black coral: Despite the name, the living colony is actually white — only its internal skeleton is black. Normally a deep-sea species found hundreds of metres down, in Fiordland it grows in shallow water, at depths of only 5–50 metres.
- Fiordland - 3 Crayfish pots — learn to bait, set, retrieve, size and process Crayfish (lobster)
- Learn to process fish, and different techniques for smoking fish and using the catch
- Handheld radios
- Nature walks
- Waterfalls and rainbows
- Spectacular scenery
- Visits to historic sites
- Wildlife: dolphins, whales, penguins, seals, seabirds (3 species of albatross), deer, native NZ birds and more
- All safety equipment
- Internet onboard if required. POA

Day Trip or Overnight Trips

- Departing from Queenstown, Wanaka, Milford Sound, or Te Anau, enjoy a scenic flight on an Airbus Squirrel accommodating up to 5-6 people (with a weight limit of 600 kg) over the stunning New Zealand mountains.
- Experience a remote 10-minute landing at Humboldts or Isobel Glacier, or a similar location (the landing site will be determined based on weather conditions on the day).
